	<p>If you are in danger, trapped, afraid, worried or think you may be suffering from abuse you can contact a person you trust, a doctor, the hospital, a teacher, a social worker. You can contact 999 if need to escape if you are hurt or injured.</p> <p>It is important that you get the help you need.</p> <p>You can report it to us easily by telephoning us on 01639 354314.</p>
	<p>If you have a Safeguarding Concern about any of the team or someone on the Register or someone being cared for.</p> <p>You can also email us at: enquiries@vcpr.co.uk</p>
	<p>If you or someone you are concerned about is in danger, is suffering abuse, hurt, injured or a crime has happened we will let a doctor, police or the council safeguarding team know.</p> <p>We do this by acting quickly.</p>
	<p>We will ask you questions about your concern and all concerns are taken very seriously. It is important to give us all of the information so we can help to keep people safe.</p> <p>Then we investigate your concern and decide what happens next about what you have reported to us.</p>
<h1>Help</h1>	<p>We are here to help. You can tell us more information when you can by contacting us again.</p> <p>We will not share your details with who you made the report about but we will need to collect them.</p>
